A RESOLUTION OF THE PINAL COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, SUPPORTING THE ARIZONA CORPORATION COMMISSION'S INVESTIGATION OF WATER QUALITY, BILLING, WASTEWATER FACILITY ISSUES AND RELATED HEALTH AND SAFETY ISSUES RELATING TO JOHNSON UTILITIES.

WHEREAS, Pinal County has received numerous complaints relating to air emissions from Johnson Utilities facilities as well as poor water quality and billing issues experienced by Johnson Utility customers; and

WHEREAS, Pinal County has been required to address sanitary sewer breaks and overflows on and around County right of way; and

WHEREAS, The Pinal County Air Quality Control District has taken enforcement action against Johnson Utilities for violations of the County's hydrogen sulfide standard and the County continues to receive complaints regarding odors from Johnson Utilities Section 11 wastewater treatment plant and associated facilities; and

WHEREAS, Based on complaints heard at public meetings for the pending rate case filed by Johnson Utilities docket number WS-02987A-17-0392 the Arizona Corporation Commission has opened an investigation of water quality, billing, wastewater facility issues and related health and safety issues for Johnson Utilities docket number WS-02987A-18-0050.
