PUBLIC NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT SESSION AND CHANGE OF HEARING DATE ON AJO IMPROVEMENT COMPANY, INC.'S APPLICATIONS FOR A PERMANENT RATE INCREASE DOCKET NOS. WS-01025A-17-0361, E-01025A-17-0362, WS-01025A-17-0363

On December 5, 2017, Ajo Improvement Company ("AIC" or "Company") filed applications with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a permanent revenue increase of 504% for its Wastewater Division, 132.5% for its Electric Division, and 356.97% for its Water Division, to be phased in over 5 years.

On March 2, 2018, AIC mailed a notice to customers advising them that the hearing on the applications would be heard by the Commission on July 19, 2018, and that public comment on the applications would be taken prior to the beginning of the hearing.

On May 7, 2018, a Revised Rate Case Procedural Order was issued by the Commission resetting the hearing on the applications for November 15, 2018, as requested by the parties.

The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") is in the process of reviewing the applications, and has not made any recommendations regarding AIC's requests. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by AIC, Staff, or any Intervenor. The Commission will determine the appropriate ratemaking treatment related to AIC's applications based on the evidence presented in this proceeding.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning **November 15, 2018, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the Commission's Tucson offices, Room No. 222, 400 West Congress. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing.

Written public comments may be submitted by mailing a letter referencing Docket Nos. WS-01025A-17-0361, E-01025A-17-0362, WS-01025A-17-0363 to Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, AZ 85007, or by submitting comments on the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) using the "Submit a Public Comment for a Utility" function. If you do not intervene in this proceeding, you will receive no further notice of the proceedings in this docket. However, all documents filed in this docket are available online (usually within 24 hours after docketing) at the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-Docket function.

About Intervention

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested persons may intervene. An interested person may be granted intervention if the outcome of the case will directly and substantially impact the person, and the person's intervention will not unduly broaden the issues in the case. Intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other parties' witnesses. Intervention is not required if you want to appear at the hearing and provide public comment on the Application, or if you want to file written comments in the record of the case.

To request intervention, you must file an original and 13 hard copies of a written request to intervene with Docket Control, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, AZ 85007, no later than September 10, 2018. You also must serve a copy of the request to intervene on each party of record on the same day that you file the request to intervene with the Commission. Information about what intervention means, including an explanation of the rights and responsibilities of an intervenor, is available on the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) using the "I Want To" tab, and clicking on "Intervene in a Utility Case" link. The link also includes sample intervention requests and a fillable form.

If you choose to request intervention, your request must contain the following:

1. Your name, address, and telephone number, and the name, address, and telephone number of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made, if not yourself;
2. A reference to Docket Nos. WS-01025A-17-0361, E-01025A-17-0362, and WS-01025A-17-0363;
3. A short statement explaining:
 - a. Your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of AIC, etc.);
 - b. How you will be directly and substantially affected by the outcome of the case, and
 - c. Why your intervention will not unduly broaden the issues in the case;
4. A statement certifying that you have served a copy of the request to intervene on the Company or its attorney and all other parties of record in the case; and
5. If you are not represented by an attorney who is an active member of the Arizona State Bar, and you are not representing yourself as an individual, sufficient information and any appropriate documentation to demonstrate compliance with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31, 38, 39, and 42, as applicable.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before September 10, 2018.


